This seminar entitled “Educational pathways: how to strengthen the bridges and links between higher education and vocational training to meet the needs of the socio-economic world?” provided an opportunity to gather decision-makers, university representatives, socio-economic partners, experts and more in general regional actors interested in the reflection on the development of higher education and vocational training pathways. This allowed for the definition of concrete follow-up actions aimed at strengthening cooperation in the field.

Both universities’ participation and the welcoming attitude and openness of the socio-economic institutional actors in the light of the topic chosen showed how relevant it was to organise this event at this time, and other activities in the same domain will certainly be planned.

This provided a chance to take stock of the current state of the actions that have already been launched on this matter in the Euro-Mediterranean region, to identify their impact within the universities and to determine concrete follow-up actions to strengthen regional cooperation in this field.

Three round tables were organised around the three following topics:

1. Articulation of public policies of Higher Education and Vocational Training: good practices, difficulties and perspectives
2. How to improve the dialogue between universities-Vocational Training centres and companies: exchange of experiences and good practices
3. The benefits of a multi-stakeholder regional dialogue to take up the challenge of youth employability, key factor for regional stability and integration in the Mediterranean
